Natural or legal persons, interested can apply for the withdrawal of the specifications from the office of specifications management at the level of EPIC-BCL, against payment of the sum of **Ten Thousand Algerian Dinars 10,000.00 DA**. Paid to the account n °:**00 200 025 250 256 000 119**, open at the External Bank of Algeria/Agency N°:25/ Beni Mered / Blida.

The people delegated for the withdrawal of the specifications must provide the following documents:

- A copy of valid identity document;
- In case of the absence of the concerned person, a power of attoreney must be presented;

- The original copy of the payment receipt for the amount due.

Tenders must be sent before (4.00 pm) on the last day of the deadline for the submission of tenders fixed in the tender specifications.
